### **INGREDIENTS**

Molasses Products, Hydrolyzed Feather Meal, Calcium Carbonate, Monocalcium Phosphate, Magnesium Oxide, Dehydrated Aspergillus Oryzae Fermentation Extract, Vegetable Oil, Manganous Oxide, Zinc Oxide, Cobalt Sulfate, Ethylenediamine Dihydrochloride, Vitamin A acetate, Colicalciferol (Vitamin D supplement), Di-alpha-tocopheryl acetate (Vitamin E supplement), Sodium Selenite and Ethoxyquin (a preservative), Salt (NaCl), max 0.00% (none added).

### **FEEDING RECOMMENDATIONS**

- 1 Provide one 200 lb. tub for every 25-35 head. Average consumption per 1,000 lb. weight animal should be 8-16 ounces or .50 to 1 lbs. per head per day.
2. Product should be available continuously. Locate tubs near a source of water, salt or loafing area. On open range locate tubs where animals congregate, near gaps or along trails.
3. Variables in consumption could be temperature, humidity, type of animal, animal size, stage of production and animal health. The quality, source availability of rough-age and/or light grain may also affect consumption. Measure product upon first introduction to figure consumption. Tub holds approximately 18 lb. per inch. Increase consumption by decreasing number of head or adding another tub. To reduce consumption, increase number of head or move tubs away from congregating areas. If this fails, remove a tub.
4. Always provide a fresh, clean source of water and free choice salt.
